- ESHA is founding member of EREC- the European Renewable Energy Council



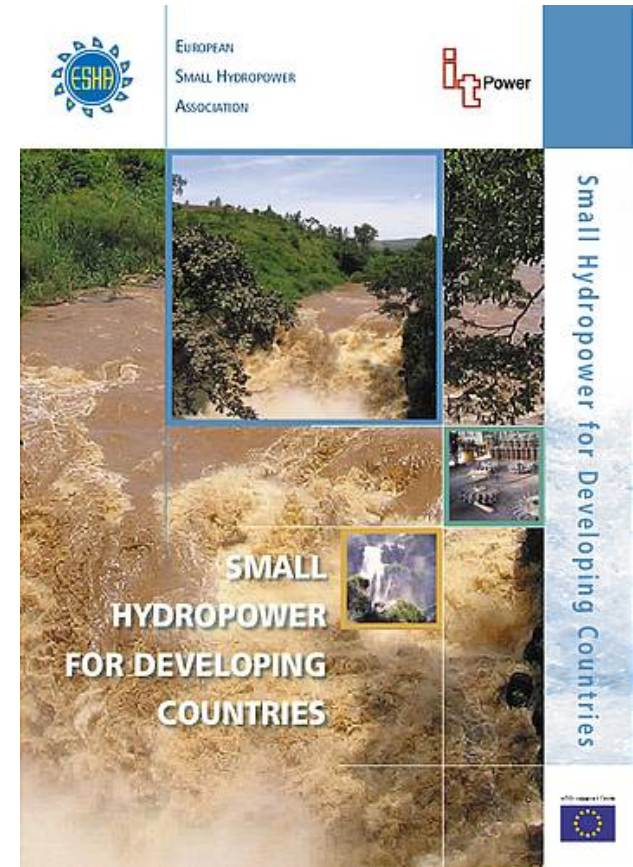
# ESHA Objectives
